« Blackbeard was a picture book pirate, with a wild look and a cruel smile. He wore lighted candles in his hair drank rum flavoured with gunpowder and hung his platted black beard behing his ears.

The myth and the reality are impossible to distinguish. He had 14 wives and nearly as many names: Drummond, Thatch and Tash, although officially he was Edward Teach. Hardly surprising then, that he terrified the sailors of the eighteenth century. Blackbeard was the buccaneers who had been previously expelled from their islands. During the fighting Blackbeard placed smouldering wicks under his hat to appear as in a thick cloud of smoke. Blackbeard wore six guns hanging from his belt and was very elegant. He drank only tea, never swore and respected the sabbath.

On the 22nd of November 1718, at the Battle of Ocracoke Island, Lt. Robert Maynard's mission was to capture the formidable pirate Blackbeard. He set up an ambush and attacked the pirate's ship. The plan was a brilliant one and successful at that. At the end of the battle, whilst examining Blackbeard's dead body, Maynard discovered no less than five bullet wounds and more than 20 knife or sword lacerations. Blackbeard's headless body was thrown into the sea and his head was hung on the bowsprit of Maynard's sloop.»


